Shutters Unlimited has new line of security windows and doors

Río Piedras-based Shutters Unlimited has introduced a new line of security windows and doors and has revamped its showroom. Shutters owner Fernando Fernández said the new line promises to return tranquility to homeowners in times when security is gold.

The windows and doors are made of aluminum and have a half inch integrated security bar, one-fourth inch thick glass on windows and laminated glass on doors, and rivets and bolts made of stainless steel. According to Fernández, the new security windows and doors are meant to protect from criminal activity but are also ideal to protect homes from hurricane winds. The windows and doors can withstand winds of up to 225 mph and are certified by the Miami Dade County. “Shutters Unlimited will cover all of your needs to protect your property from the weather and vandalism,” said Fernández.
